Effective January 1, 2025

(Use to budget for work periods beginning January 1, 2025.)
 The following table illustrates the "Cost to You" of employing someone.

You are certainly free to pay an employee any amount you desire (\$17.77, 20.13, etc.) as long as your wages are within the State's funding parameters and at least minimum wage for your specific area.

You can calculate a rough "cost to you" by multiplying the wage you wish to pay by 1.045.
